

## Three ways to get from Sydney's International or Domestic Airport (Kingsford Smith Airport) to 29 Orwell Street Potts Point, 2011.

You need to keep in mind that Kings Cross is not a suburb. It's actually an area within the suburb of Potts Point. All prices are quoted in \$AUD and all time estimates are correct at normal times.

We use to recommend the Airport Shuttle Buses but we don't any more. The trip duration can vary too much and you don't want to be the last drop off.

### 1. Taxi 25 – 40 minutes, @ \$35 - \$50 one-way.

The easiest and most expensive transport solution. Get in and specify 29 Orwell Street or tell them the closest intersection is the corner of Orwell and MacLeay Street Potts Point.

Be prepared to pay up to \$50 for the taxi-fare. And add another 5% if you plan to use a credit card. It might be possible to find someone else heading towards the city or even better Kings Cross and share the fare.

The taxi ranks are well marked at airport exits

### 2. Train 30 - 40 minutes, \$18 one-way + 5 minute walk.

If you like trains, catching a train from the airport is one of the fastest ways to reach Sydney Airport using public transport. Services run directly from the city centre to stations located inside the Domestic and International terminals. You will need to walk 400 metres (440 Yards) for 5 minutes with cases from the Station to the apartment.

It only takes 15 minutes to travel from Central Station to Domestic Airport Station and 18 minutes to International Airport Station. This does not include wait time and I would count on 24 – 36 minutes in to total, again without waiting time. Perhaps allow for an hour all up.

On weekdays there are approximately six to eight services every hour from 6.00am until 10.00pm, and then four per hour until the last train. On weekends and public holidays there are four services per hour. Allow at least 1 hour travel time.

The fare is \$17 - \$18 per adult one-way. Return is ~\$35 per adult. Childs fare / Student is \$14 one-way, ~\$23 return. Off-peak can save you a couple of dollars, and

off-peak not applicable to Child / Student fare. Child is 15 year old or less. Child 3-year-old or less travel free. Use the fare calculator to find the ticket that's right for you. A bonus is that you can buy a ticket using a credit card.

## Directions for the trains.

- From: International or Domestic Airport Station, Mascot
- To: Kings Cross Station, Sydney
- Board Train at Airport Platform 1 and head toward the city.
- Get off at Townhall Station (8 stops past the domestic airport).
- Board the Eastern Suburbs & Illawarra Line heading towards Bondi Junction.
- Get off at Kings Cross Station (2 stops after Town hall).

## Directions from the station on foot.

- Walk out of the station and onto Darlinghurst Road. The main retail strip of the Kings Cross area.
- Turn left when you exit the station and walk 100 Metres to Llankelly Place, and on the same side of the road as the station exit.
- Walk down Llankelly Place 100 metres and you will come to Orwell Street.
- It's on the left at the end of Llankelly Place. From this point you should be about 10 metres from the front door.

An **alternate train route** from the airport is via Woolli Creek Station. Change at Wolli Creek onto the Eastern Suburbs & Illawarra Line heading towards Bondi Junction. Get off at Kings Cross Station (2 stops after Townhall). And then follow the on foot directions once you leave the station. Some would say this is easier as you avoid the busy Townhall Station platform stop.

## 3. Ride with Uber from Sydney Airports. 40 minutes, ~\$50

### How to get picked up at SYD Airport

#### **Request when you're ready to walk outside.**

Choose a ride option that suits your group size and luggage storage needs, and enter your pickup location in the app.

**Exit the terminal.**

Head outside to your pickup location. The pickup location will depend on the type of vehicle you select. Please refer to the instructions below to find out where to meet your driver

**Look for your driver.**

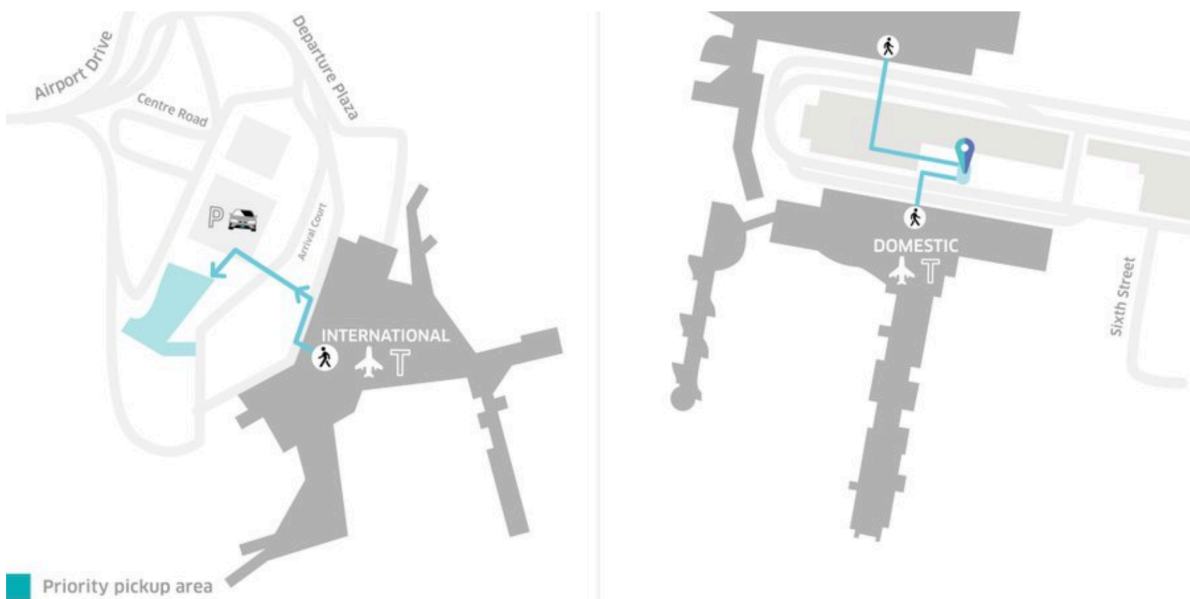
If you can't find your driver, contact him or her through the app.

**Where to meet your driver at SYD Airport**

Your pickup location at Sydney Airport depends on your terminal and ride options.

For T1 International Terminal, follow the bright green signs to the Priority Pickup area for your uberX, uberXL or UberSELECT ride. For all other ride options, head to the limo pickup area.

For T2 Domestic Terminal, follow the signs to the Priority Pickup zone for your uberX, uberXL or UberSELECT ride. For all other ride options, head outside to the general passenger pickup area.
